What's a M.O.M. Group and how do I begin one?

A M.O.M. Group is a gathering of moms of all ages who meet to do their mom-journey together. It's Titus 2 in real life with a missional twist to help local churches reach their communities and this culture through the power and beauty of mentoring.

Begin a M.O.M. Group as a small group or as a one-on-one organic relationship. Meet in a church, a classroom, a dining room table, a park, or at a local coffee shop.

A typical M.O.M. Group Schedule in a church, ministry or home:

- 9:00 a.m. ~ Opening Prayer / Meet & Greet Icebreakers / K.I.D. s Group
- 9:15 a.m. ~ Practical Tip Time ~ Make a meal / Learn Excel / Create a Budget
- 9:45 a.m. ~ M.O.M. to Mom time (study/grow/chat/biblical mommyhood)
- 10:30 a.m. ~ Snack food fest / Chit-chat / Clean up
- 10:45 a.m. ~ Pick up children from K.I.D. Group
